MESSAGE FROM HOG SAFETY OFFICER HOG Safety Article October 2022


Whether your bike is a Harley Davidson or a different brand of motorcycle, riding can be exhilarating and fun, but also dangerous – so keep safety in mind. Injuries or worse can be the result of ignoring safety. No one ever intends to be in an accident – so it could happen to you.

- Consider taking a motorcycle riding course. If you took one a long time ago, take one again to refresh your skills. You should make a point of being a lifelong motorcycle riding learner.
- Always wear safety gear. Accidents happen and gear protects you from injury.
- Gloves will help you maintain your grip on your handlebars. Wear them no matter the weather conditions.
- Never
 ride if you've been drinking or are under the influence of a drug. That
 includes prescription or over the counter medications that can
 interfere with your reflexes and ability to pay attention.
- Know the limits of your skills and ride within them.
- Do
 your best to be visible. The most common reason a driver gives for
 hitting a motorcyclist is, "I never saw him". Try to have something
 conspicuous on your person or bike to be seen. Always assume that
 drivers around you don't see you and react accordingly.
- Just like driving any vehicle, ride consistently. Unexpected actions are the types of things that will confuse another driver and that can cause an accident. The freedom of riding your Harley Davidson can be exciting. Just don't forget your safety while you are enjoying it. Otherwise it could be your last ride.
