

## State of Tennessee implements In Case of Emergency Contact list:

I found this online and mentioned at the Chapter HOG Waller that I would post this in the newsletter.

Beginning in October drivers in Tennessee have a new free service available to them to go online and identify In Case of Emergency (ICE) contacts. You can enter multiple contacts that can be notified by emergency responders in the event you are in an accident and are not able to communicate on your own.

You should not only list someone like your spouse but someone not as likely to be traveling with you frequently. That way you should have someone that Police may be able to reach. Please take a few minutes and do this for yourself and your family!  
Emergency Contact Information

Tennessee drivers or identification card holders may now enter emergency contact information for use by law enforcement in crisis or emergency situations.

To submit this information into the Tennessee driver license data base, please follow these simple instructions. More than one emergency contact may be submitted.

Visit the Online Driver Services which can be found on [www.tn.gov](http://www.tn.gov) or [www.tn.gov/safety](http://www.tn.gov/safety).

From there, you must enter your last name, date of birth, Tennessee driver license or ID number, and last four digits of your social security number. Once that information is entered, click submit, then click on "Emergency Contact Information" to enter the name, phone number, email address, and relationship of the emergency contact.

You may also take advantage of other available online driver services from this page, such as renewing your driver license and changing your address.
