

#### **HOG Safety Article February 2023**

Well we are off to a cold and icy February but Spring is around the corner. For the coming year I was reminded by my old scout training of a motto we as motorcycle riders should put to use. It is "BE PREPARED"! It is easy for riders to get complacent, especially veteran riders, and not be prepared for the many events that can happen when riding a motorcycle. Do you still cover your brake and clutch levers when coming up on an intersection? Do you really know how to react when the car turns left in front of you at the intersection? Do you really know how your bike will react in a panic stop? If not I would advise you to take a motorcycle-training course. You say you took one when you started riding five years ago. Well its time you took the Experienced Riders Course (ERC). You need to take this course every so often to keep your skill sharp and to learn how your bike really handles. In this course you use your bike and you get to know exactly how fast it will stop. You will learn how it will react in a quick left and right weave maneuver. You will do this in a controlled environment with experience teachers. This training might save your life. There are two ERC courses scheduled this spring. March 19 and April 19. Email me to sign up. Cost is \$125 and you get \$50 back in Harley bucks. Only 7 riders per class. Below is monthly safety tip.



# ONE RULE That Will Keep You Alive On City Streets

Of all the things that we learn being out on the streets with our bikes, one stands out as the all time lifesaver in my book.

If you can avoid it, never enter an intersection without another vehicle on your right side. It should be noted that this advice assumes you ride in a country where people drive on the right side of the road.)

If you have to slow down in order to let a vehicle catch up with you on the right side, or if you have to increase speed a little so that you catch up with another vehicle, having one on your right side is as safe as it gets for entering an intersection.


Obviously this also means that if you are stopped at a traffic light and it turns green, you enter the intersection when the vehicle on your right does - no jackrabbit jumps if you want to live. Too tame? Could be, but this rider likes it that way. In fact, I'd rather that the vehicle on my right was a bus or even an 18-wheeler.

By the way, it is safer that the vehicle be on your right than on the left. The closer you can be to the center of the intersection when you go thru it, the more air there is (on average) between you and somebody that comes at you from either side. This is just another way of saying that if you have to enter the intersection by yourself, do it in the left most lane.

Keep the shiny side up. Larry- HOG Safety Officer

Our January account balance started at \$7,563.94, and we ended the month with \$7,619.22.

You may have noticed a few changes to the Memphis HOG Website. I deleted some items and added others to freshen-up the site. I inserted a chapter photo in the lower section of the Home Page. For all of you that participated in the Annual Ski-Freeze on New Year's Day, the group photo that was taken with the I40 bridge in the back ground, I thought it was worthy of a Home Page feature. There was a good turn-out amongst all of you that day and maybe as close as we come to getting our most active members in a single photograph. I also used that photograph in the Photo Gallery home page.

A new member form was substituted. There were minor changes made by National HOG. The form has been placed under the "Memphis HOG Form" button on the Membership Page. A majority of our membership have already renewed.

There is a link on the Home page connecting to the 2023 National HOG Rallies. The Harley Davidson 120<sup>th</sup> Anniversary is shown in July for which we have a number of members planning to attend the event. If you have never been to a Regional HOG Rally, I recommend you pick at least one to attend. There are two types of rallies, stationery and touring. I personally enjoy the touring rallies as each day ends in a different city and a local Harley dealership. Often the local dealership will host a dinner, typically hamburgers and hot dogs but occasionally there is a buffet featuring food such as Italian, Mexican or BBQ to name a few. Typically, there are HOG members from the local chapter supporting the event.

Website statistics, the average number of sessions are hovering around 187 per 30-day period. The Participation page and the Calendar page continue to be the most viewed. On a 1-month snapshot on a given day there were 78 viewers entering our website directly, 61 entered the site through Google, 28 through Bing, 11 through Yahoo, 6 through DuckDuckGo, 2 from Facebook, 1 from Harley Davidson.com. The statistics show a number of sessions from visitors that are first timers and you might find it interesting that our site is viewed from other countries, people in Canada, Czechia, Germany and Sweden.

You may have noticed photos in the Photo Gallery for the Czech Republic. We have a couple of paid-up members to Memphis HOG from the Czech Republic. They occasionally send photos of their group that I insert into the gallery. They are the **Hradec Kralove HOG Chapter.** There were a couple of them that attended the 115<sup>th</sup> HOG Anniversary Celebration in Milwaukee. I remember they spotted Larry Allen and Jim Ferguson wearing their Memphis HOG vest.

#### Bonus Article Regarding Sign-In and RSVPing

Back before I was one of your Officers I would show up to a ride (or meeting) and not make much of an effort to "sign-in". I was one of those members that someone was chasing down to sign-in. I never really cared as I was not chasing points or miles so to me, it didn't make any difference. It was not until I became an Officer and attending Officer's Meeting that I realized it was more than just a member signing in. As Memphis HOG we enjoy certain benefits and protections in belonging to a larger group, the National HOG Group. Member sign-in is one of the requirements from National HOG. Should an accident occur, first and foremost we hope you are okay but, second to that, we hoped you're

Occasionally we either have reserved too many or not enough tables and chairs. We want everyone that can attend to attend but showing up without your reservation made typically means there were not enough tables reserved and people have to sit away from the main group or someone can't get a table at all. This does not mean if you did not RSVP and at the last minute you decide to attend, by all means attend. We're just asking for a little help in our planning.

#### To Join HOG National


