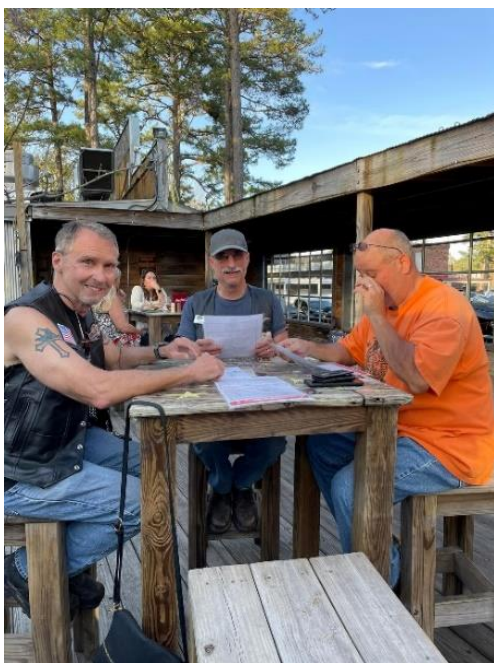

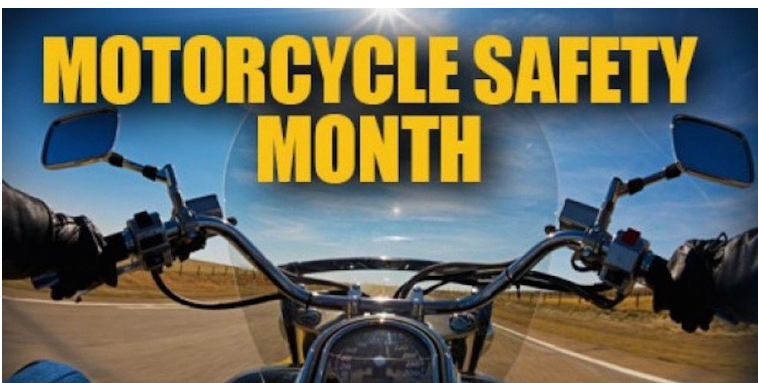
## May Is motorcycle awareness month

### scavenger hunt list and rules for 2022.

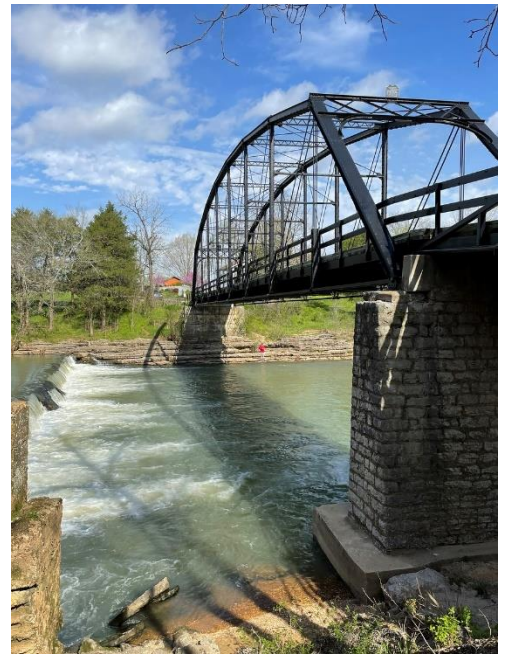
- The contest goes through Thanksgiving 2022. That means your last opportunity for a picture is Thanksgiving weekend and all entries need to be submitted to me by that Sunday midnight.
- The winner will be announced at the HOG Christmas party. The winner will be the one with the most entries submitted. If there are multiple folks with the same number of entries, then we will randomly draw a name.
- You earn entries by snapping a picture of yourself and your motorcycle in front of the object and sending that picture to me at [verbeekr@yahoo.com](mailto:verbeekr@yahoo.com). Please add the following to the subject line *Memphis HOG Scavenger Hunt*. Make sure you add which category your entry should fall under.
  - In some cases it will not be possible to have your bike in the picture, no problem, just take a selfie and explain why the bike could not be in the picture.
  - In some cases it may be easier to do a group photo, like when you are on a ride with a group and it would take up too much time to take individual pictures. Have one person from the group submit the picture with a list of names that are in the group picture.
- You can have as many entries as you can for a particular object. For instance, you go on multiple trips where you can take a picture with a ferry, submit them all and you'll receive credit for all of them. However, it has to be a different ferry for each entry.
- You do not have to take pictures during HOG events, you can do this all on your own.
- Every entry is worth 1 point. You can get 5 points maximum in each item.
- All decisions on whether or not an entry is valid will be made by me and are final (no whining allowed).

## MESSAGE FROM HOG SAFETY OFFICER HOG Safety Article May 2022

### **Why wear a helmet? What safety does it provide in an accident?**

What help would a helmet give to a motorcycle rider if they crash at 60-70 miles per hour depends on how they crashed.

If the rider went smack into a brick wall, or a semi truck, the helmet would likely do nothing. However, that's not what most crashes are.

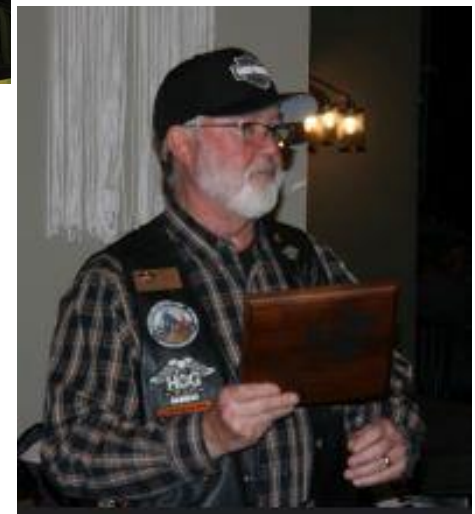
Riders predominantly crash into passenger cars, which is lots more common on the street than on the highway, or they wipe out and slide.

Hitting a passenger car almost universally results in getting thrown from the bike, flying over the car, and face-planting on the other side of it. Helmet, obviously, keeps your face from being sanded off by the pavement and your skull from cracking. Note that even though your vehicle speed might have been 70, crashing into the car slows you down, and by the time you hit the ground, you are moving a lot slower.

If you go down without immediately hitting something, you are going 70, but horizontally. The vertical speed when you hit the ground isn't much more than the speed you pick up falling from a chair. Not that your head won't hurt if you do that. In this circumstance, abrasion is the big danger. Have you ever tripped and skinned your knee on the pavement? That was, maybe, 1-2 mile an hour slide. Bet it hurt. A 70 mile an hour slide will grind off your skin and other soft things. So, a helmet keeps your scalp, nose, and ears attached to your skull. And it cushions the relatively low impact of the fall.

Look at what these helmets all have in common:

### Photographer

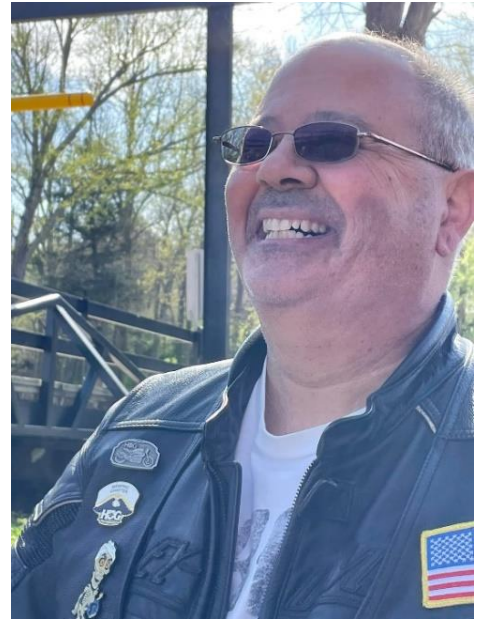
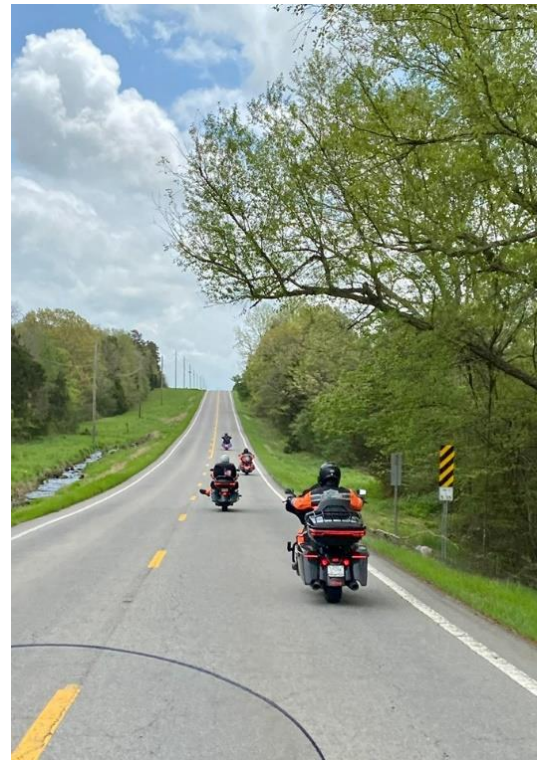
